
SERVICE INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE PV212 HYDRAULIC HAND PUMP

SERVICE KIT PART No. PV212-SK



Before carrying out these procedures, disconnect pump from external system & release any residual pressure from the pump.

Main Piston Seal

- 1. Withdraw handle/piston assembly from cylinder by removing the two socket head screws marked "x" above.
- 2. Clean oil and grease from piston & cylinder and remove the old piston seal & backup ring.
- 3. Fit new piston seal & backup ring. (see sketch above)
- 4. Grease piston seal & piston using silicone grease. (not supplied)
- 5. Refit handle/piston assembly to cylinder and tighten screws.

Fine Control Seal

- 1. Remove fine control assembly from pump body using a 19mm A/F spanner on the flats.
- 2. With the flats held in a vice, unscrew the large nut and withdraw the piston assembly.
- 3. Clean oil & grease from piston & cylinder and remove the old piston seal and backup ring.
- 4. Fit new piston seal & backup ring. (see sketch)
- 5. Lightly grease piston seal & backup ring using silicone grease.

Release Valve Seal

- 1. Turn release valve knob fully anticlockwise and pull out the valve screw from its body. Take care not to lose the steel ball that lies beneath the screw.
- 2. Remove the old seal from its groove in the valve screw and replace with a new one.
- 3. Lightly grease the seal with silicone grease and reassemble ensuring the steel ball is correctly in place.

NOTE: Use qualified pressure instrumentation personnel and good engineering practice for all the procedures in this publication.
